## Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 217.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAIN-TENANCE OF THE CITY WATER WORKS.

WHEREAS, the smeunt of money heretofore appropriates to maintain the city water works for the fiscal year of 1913 has been spent, and no funds are available to maintain the said water works for the balance of the year 1913, therefore an unferencen contingency has arisen, making it necessary to pass an emergency ordinance to appropriate money to maintain the water works of the City of Grand Junction for the balance of the year 1913;

Wherefore, Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Crand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses of the city water works for the remainder of the present fiscal year ending December 31, 1913, the sum of \$300.00.
