ORDINANCE NO. 231.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO WATER RENTS.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 206, entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," passed and adopted December 3rd, 1912, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

The annual rates for the use of water from the city water works used within the city limits are hereby established, payable quarterly in advance, as in this ordinance provided, for each:

Residence, hospital, sanitarium, hotel and office buliding of four rooms or less	\$12.00
And \$2.00 for each additional room over four rooms.	
Drug Store	\$20.00
Fire Hydrants, each	\$12.00
Street sprinkling wagons, all	\$300.00
City Parks, all	\$200.00
Bakery and Candy Factory, according to amuont of water used	
\$20.00 to	\$30.00
Restaurant, from \$15.00 to	\$30.00
according to amount of water used.	
Soft Drink Parlor and Club, according to amount of water used,	
\$20.00 to	\$25.00
Store not otherwise specified	\$12.00
Soda Fountain	\$6.00
Barber Shop, one chair	\$12.00
Each additional chair	\$3.00
Public Bath Room, one tub	\$7.00
Each additional tub	\$3.50
Photograph Gallery	\$15.00 to \$25.00
According to amount of water used.	
Hand Laundry	\$20.00 to \$30.00
According to amount of water used.	
Steam Laundry	\$160.00
Livery Stable, from	\$65.00 to \$100.00
According to amount of water used.	
Public Automobile Garage, from	\$20.00 to \$30.00
According to amount of water used.	
Dentist Parlor, per chair	\$6.00
Vegetable Fountain	\$10.00
Urinal	\$12.00
School Houses in School District No. 1, per scholar	.10
Water sold from hydrant, per tank wagon	.25
Each bottling establishment, brick yard, chemical laboratory, railway establishment, steam boiler, and all other concerns not mentioned, according to the amount of water used; provided, however, that the minimum annual rent to any water user shall be	\$12.00
