We, the undersigned, acting as canvassing board, hereby certify that we have canvassed the returns of the municipal election held in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, on April 4th, 1933, and from the said canvass find the results to be as follows: that 261 ballots were cast in District "A"; that 238 ballots were cast in District "B"; that 282 ballots were cast in District "C"; that 283 ballots were cast in District "D"; that 536 ballots were cast in District "E", making a total number of 1600 ballots cast in all the Districts at said election.
