## Historic Preservation Board Meeting Minutes – January 4, 1999

- Acknowledgement of WPA/New Deal Era Buildings/Projects in the Grand Valley
- Historic Video about canal system (Kristen to find out status)
- Workshop on Researching Your Home's History
- Reception honoring City's "Preservation Angels" see information from Boone, North Carolina
- Contact Judy Prosser-Armstrong, the current President of the Mesa County Historical Society to coordinate an activity and general research projects. A history of one-room school houses was one research project suggested.

The Board will further discuss these ideas at the February meeting.
