

ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. The salaries of employees of the City filling the following named offices shall be as herein given, said salary to be payable at the close of each and every month.

City Attorney\$75.00
Janitor at the City Hall35.00

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief of Police\$115.00
Assistant Chief of Police95.00
Night Policeman90.00
Special Night Policeman40.00

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Health\$40.00 Officer

For any work performed by the City Engineer for the City, pay shall be not more than: \$1.50 per hour for the first ten days; from ten days to a full month not more than \$1.25 per hour (for field work)

Section 2. Ordinance No. 197 passed Feb. 10th, 1912, is hereby repealed.
