ORDINANCE NO. 270

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OF WEEDS, BRUSH, TIN CANS AND RUBBISH ON LOTS OR TRACTS IN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, AND ALSO FORBIDDING BARBED WIRE FENCES IN CERTAIN PLACES.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section. 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, agent, occupant or lessee of any lot or tract of ground in the City of Grand Junction to allow or permit the accumulation thereon of dead weeds, brush, tin cans or rubbish of any kind.

Sec. 2. No person shall construct, keep or maintain a barb wire fence along or near a city street that has a public sidewalk along or near the property line.

Sec. 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction be fined in a sum not less than two (\$2.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each and every offense.
