## ORDINANCE NO. 273.

THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1st, A. D. 1919, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31st, A. D. 1919.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, A. D. 1919, and ending December 31, A. D. 1919, to-wit:

FirstFor the General Fund\$5,300.00
SecondFor salaries of City officers and employees9,300.00
ThirdFor lighting the streets and public buildings9,000.00
FourthFor maintaining the Police department5,240.00
FifthFor maintaining the Fire department8,880.00
SixthFor maintaining, improving and repairing
the streets and alleys and water for irrigation
SeventhFor maintaining the Health department5,200.00
EighthFor maintenance and repairs City sewers200.00
NinthFor maintaining, extending, repairing and operating
the City water works
TenthFor care and improvement of the public parks4,500.00
EleventhFor the maintenance of the Free Public Library2,500.00
TwelfthFor special assessment in paving district
and water frontage asessment942.72
ThirteenthFor interest on Water Bonds
FourteenthFor principal on General bonds2,000.00

Sec. 2. That for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1919, and ending December 31, 1919, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Grand Junction, both real and personal, the following amounts for special and general taxes, to-wit:

First--For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of the Free Public Library, a tax of thirty-three one-hundredths (.33) of one mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

Second--For the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said City of Grand Junction, and for the payment of interest on outstanding bonds and warrants and for the payment of a portion of the bond indebtedness of said City, a tax of seven and thirty-seven one-hundredths (7.37) mills on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.
