GRAND JUNCTION PLANNING COMMISSION Special Hearing: November 22, 1988 7:30 p.m. - 7:36 p.m.

The special hearing of the Grand Junction Planning Commission was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Love.

Other Commission members attending the hearing included: Jack Campbell, Karen Madsen, and Jim Tyson.

Mike Sutherland was present from the Planning Department, and Terri Troutner was also present to record the minutes.

Approximately 33 interested citizens attended the hearing.

Chairman Madsen seconded the motion.

A vote was called, and the motion passed by a vote of 3-1, with Commissioner Madsen opposing.

MOTION: (COMMISSIONER CAMPBELL) "MR. CHAIRMAN, ON ITEM #38-88, CONSIDERATION OF FINAL PLAT FOR FILING FIVE OF NORTHRIDGE ESTATES, I MOVE THAT WE DENY THIS REQUEST."

Commissioner Tyson seconded the motion.

A vote was called and the motion passed by a vote of 3-1, with Commissioner Madsen opposing.
