## I. MINUTES APPROVED

Hearing no objections, the Chairman declared the minutes of the December 24th meeting approved as written.

### ZOMING HEARING ON MESTERN MEAT PACKERS ANNEXATION II.

Don Marner showed the map of Mestern Meat Packers Annexation and explained the location. Discussion followed. Plake Chambliss moved and Grace Smith seconded the Commission recommend to Council that Western Heat Packers Annexation be zoned I-1 (Light Industry). Motion massed.

### -UIII. ZOHING HEAPING ON MORTH WILLOWBROOK ANNEXATION

After explanation of location of Morth Millowbrook Annexation on the map and explanation from the Zoning Ordinance of R-1-A Zoning, it was stated that the petition for this zoning was 100%. Dick Stranger moved and Blake Chambliss seconded the Commission recom-mend to Council that North Millowbrook Annexation be zoned P-1-A (One-family Residence). Motion passed.

#### IV. ZOPING HEARING OF GAME FARM AREA ANNEXATION

Explanation of zoning was given. Discussion followed. Stranger moved and Blake Chambliss seconded the Commission recommend to Council that the Parklane Annexation (Game Farm) be zoned R-2 (Two-family Residence).

#### ٧. DISCUSSION OF HOUSING CODE STUDY GROUP

Don Warner showed the maps of the City which he had been asked to make. These were first divided into the five voting districts, then broken down into smaller sections. After discussion it was decided the Commission get a City Voter Pedistration List from the County Clerk's Office to nublish in the City Hall. Commission should have this list prepared and present it to the City Council by their next meeting, January 15th.

Blake Chambliss moved and Dick Stranger seconded the Commission recommend to the Council that the selection of Committee members be twelve names from each voting district chosen at random from the City Voter Registration List. Motion passed.
