I. MINUTES APPROVED.

II. DATE FOR ZONING HEARING SET.

Mr. Warner showed the Commission the locations to be considered at the Zoning Hearing. $M^{C}Cary$ and Heller Tracts proposed for R-3 zoning would be consistant with the ajoining areas. A letter from the Teller Arns Inc. was read into the minutes by Mr. Baker. Teller Arms is requesting change of Block 2 from B-1 to B-3, Block 1, Lots 1, 2, and 3 from R-1C to B-3, Block 1, Lots 4, 5, 6, and 7 from R-1C to R-3.

Petitions have been presented requesting a change for the north halfs of City Blocks 1, 2, and 3 from B-1 to C-1. A discussion was held on the various changes and it was decided a Zoning Hearing would be held within 30 days.

III. SALES TAX SLIDE SHOW.

Mr. Novak showed the Commission members a slide presentation of the recent financial studies. A discussion on the proposed sales tax followed.
