# I. MINUTES APPROVED.

Mr. Warner stated that the date should be 3 months after the last regularly scheduled Quarterly Hearing. The Hearing was scheduled for November 18, 1964.

Mr. Stranger suggested that there was a possibility of State statuates requiring zoning matters within the County and within 2 miles of the City Limits to be refered to the City. It was suggested that Mr. Stranger take this matter to the County Commissioners and ask that the County Planning Attorney investigate further.
