JOINT MEETING of

CITY PLANNING COMMISSION, COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION, and OFFICIALS OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 51

Tuesday, April 24th, 1956, at 7:00 P.M.

The City Planning Commission held a joint meeting with the County Planning Commission and School Officials to receive information from Trafton Bean regarding possible Federal aid for regional planning.

It was explained that to qualify for Federal aid it would be necessary to have a formal regional organization. At present the three groups have been operating on a regional basis, but with only a mutual agreement.

All present agreed that it would be advantageous for over-all coordination to form the groups into a legal Regional Planning Group.

In view of the fact that a quorum of the City Commission was present and that it was highly probable that a quorum could not attend the Commission's regular meeting the following day and also that only one item had been filed for action, the Commission decided to act upon the petition of Dr. Graves, et al for annexation of a tract of land to be known as Kister Addition at the NE corner of Orchard Avenue and College Place.

It was moved by McMullin and seconded by Harper that the Commission recommend to the City Council that the petition for annexing this area be approved and that it be zoned Business "A".

Motion carried.

It was moved by McMullin and seconded by Harper that the Chairman authorize two members of the Commission to meet with representatives of the County Planning Commission to discuss mutual problems until a Regional Planning Commission could be formed. Motion carried. Claud Smith and Howard McMullin were so authorized.

There being no further business, the Commission adjourned.
