

GRAND JUNCTION PLANNING COMMISSION

Wednesday, August 14, 1957

SPECIAL MEETING

The first breakfast meeting of the Planning Commission was held Wednesday morning, August 14, 1957 at 7:00 A. M. at the Uranium Club with the following members present: Chairman Al Cornelison, Claud Smith, Robert VanDeusen, Laird Smith, and Secretary R. E. Cheever.

This meeting was followed at 8:00 A. M. by a meeting in the offices of Regional Planning Director Gene Allen in the Court House. In addition to those present at the breakfast meeting, Mrs. Cleo Diemer and Richard Zollner were present at the 8:00 o'clock meeting.

Absent were Mrs. Estelle Brumbaugh and Howard McMullin.

Mr. Allen explained to the Commission what has been accomplished in the past and what developments have taken place in regard to subdivisions, and brought them up to date on plans involving subdivisions. He then explained the zoning planning district and the land use map and plans.

After discussion and recommendation that the Regional Planning Commission be supported with a larger budget next year by the City, motion was made by Laird Smith that the City include \$10,000.00 in the budget for next year's operations; motion was seconded by Claud Smith, and carried.

An Annexation Committee was appointed. Placed on this Committee were: Laird K. Smith, Robert VanDeusen, and Mrs. Estelle Brumbaugh. The first problem confronting this committee will be the Fruitvale annexation.

The meeting was then adjourned for two weeks, to meet again at 7:00 A. M. on Wednesday, August 28, 1957, for a breakfast at the Uranium Club, followed by a meeting at 8:00 o'clock in the Regional Planning Director's office at which time Mr. Allen will continue his explanation of the accomplishments and aims of the Commission.
