

ORDINANCE NO. 320.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR PROTECTION OF COLORADO RIVER BANK.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year of 1922, an unforeseen contingency has arisen because of the danger of unusually high waters, necessitating repairs and strengthening of the Colorado River bank south of the Main Street bridge and on the east bank of said river.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated, for the purpose of repairing and strengthening the Colorado River bank, south of the Main Street bridge and on the east bank of said river, the sum of \$700.00.

Section 2. That said sum of \$700.00 be appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Grand Junction.
