

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
Special Meeting

Friday evening, 7:30 P.M., February 21, 1947.

Present: Chairman Sternberg, Messrs. Magill,
Burnett, Borschell and Hall.

Absent: None.

Reading of the minutes of the meeting of
January 17 was waived.

Chairman Sternberg announced that the meeting
was intended to serve as a hearing for the proposed
change in the overall provisions of the zoning ordinance.
These changes were discussed in general by Mr. Fritz and
in considerable detail by Mr. Bennett.

It was pointed out by Chairman Sternberg and
other members of the zoning board that far too many spot
changes were being made in the zoning map and that a study
of the situation had caused the consideration of large
scale changes in zoning of the established areas of the city
carefully integrated into the proposed classifications for
zoning recently annexed areas.

The secretary was instructed to have prepared
maps showing the proposed changes in the classifications
and also was instructed to outline the changes in the
provisions of the overall zoning ordinance.

No action was taken on the various petitions
for zoning changes presented to the board.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M., and the
date of February 28, Friday, 5:00 P.M. was set as the
next meeting of the Zoning Board of Adjustment.
