

ORDINANCE NO. 322

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 307, passed and adopted FEBRUARY 15th, 1922, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 307, passed and adopted February 15th, 1922 and entitled "An Ordinance concerning salaries of certain city officers and employees" be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The following named officers and employees of the City shall receive the following monthly salaries beginning February 1st, 1922, payable at the close of each and every month, viz:

Chief of Department of Health and Parks	\$125.00
City Stenographer	90.00
Patrolmen	125.00

The Chief of Police shall receive a monthly salary of \$175.00, beginning July 1st, 1922, payable at the close of each and every month.
