Art. 1 Para. 4. "A quorum of the Board of Adjustment shall consist of three members." (This change is temporary until Sec. 9, Para. e, of the Zoning Ordinance is changed from 3 to 4, voting members is necessary to constitute a quorum.)

2. Art. I. Para. 7, line seven. "Such appeal shall be taken withing fifteen days-----"

CHANGED TO READ:

"Such appeal shall be taken within thirty days----"(to agree with Zoning Ordinance).

3. Art. V. Para 2. Change "fifteen" to"thirty" (to agree with Zoning Ordinance.)

4. Art. V. Para 3. Add the words "Chairman of the" in front of "Board" on line 2.

5. Art. VI, Para. I, line 6, Change "Fifteen" to"thirty" (to agree with Zoning Ordinance).

Motion was made, seconded, approved to recommend to the City Planning Commission, a change in Sec. 9, Para e, line 4, be changed from "three voting members" to "four voting members."

6. The Board set the second and fourth Tuesdays (evenings) as regular meeting dates if there are requests to be heard.
