I. FRONT YARD VARIANCE - MESA MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

The Board discussed the requested front yard variance for Mesa Memorial Hospital at 10th and Grand Avenue. The variance was requested by L. M. Finnessey, Administrator of the hospital, to allow the expansion of the front entrance. Mr. Robert Hightower, Architect, showed the Board sketches of the proposed remodeled entrance and explained why the variance is necessary to expand the hospital lobby.
