

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
of
THE WALKER FIELD AIRPORT BOARD
Held November 10, 1960 at Grand Junction, Colorado

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Chairman, Henry J. Tupper in the Office of the County Commissioners, Court House Annex, Grand Junction, Colorado, with the following present:
