

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
WALKER FIELD AIRPORT BOARD
Held July 10, 1967, Grand Junction, Colo.

Chairman Paul Heidel called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M.

Member present were as follows:

City Councilmen: Ed McCormick, Ray Meacham, Bob Evans
County Commissioners: Clyde Lowe, Paul Heidel, Ed Lamm

Also Present: Dave Palo, County Attorney, Gus Byrom, Airport
Manager, Richard Gray, City Manager
W.J. Anderies, Secretary, Clyde Davis.

Second item on agenda was taken as first because it could be dispensed with rather rapidly.

Second item of Business: Supplement to the agreement with United
Air Lines:

Gus Byrom suggested that a landing fee be charged for training flights.

Ray Meacham moved and Ed Lamm seconded that the Board ratify the agreement with United Air Lines. Motion carried.

Gus Byrom stated that the training flight landings were not injuring the runways.

First item of Business: "T" Hanger Project:

Gus Byrom gave the history of the project and stated the cost was \$1300.00 per unit or \$13,000.00 total payment made. The remaining two units could be modified at a cost of \$950.00 per unit plus \$250.00 for the end walls. The total credit to Clyde Davis for non use of the hangers was 176 days from September to March, 1963 for a total of \$1760.00. Since March however, Mr. Davis has not been able to use the remaining five units at a proposed cost of 117 days equal \$365.62 - bringing the total credit due Mr. Davis to \$2125.62.

Gus Byrom suggested an increase in rent from \$300.00 per month to

\$350.00 to cover the additional \$3100.00 work, plus \$500.00 for paving of the floor in the remaining hangers.

Paul Heidel moved and Bob Evans seconded that we remodel three hangers and have the committee negotiate with Clyde Davis on a fee for a ten year period. Motion carried.

Gus Byrom read a letter from the Federal Government concerning the Governmental participation to share in a High Intensity Light Generator- to the tune of approximately \$2200.00.

Meeting adjourned 10:58 A.M.
