

WALKER FIELD
 AIRPORT BOARD STUDY SESSION
 HELD MARCH 21, 1968, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

The study session convened at 7:30 P. M. Board members present were: Ed Lamm, Paul Heidel, Clyde Lowe, Ed McCormack, Ray Meacham, and Herb Wright. Also present were: Dave Palo, Gus Byrom, Dick Gray, and W. J. Anderies.

Gus Byrom presented a list of major projects as follows:

Gus Byrom stated that the costs given are high and will probably be less.

Gus felt that we should plan for the runway extension in 1969 as it was too late this year.

Landing fees presently bring in \$30,000 per year. Raising the fee to 10¢ per 1,000 will bring in \$60,000. He felt that the cost of a new terminal will be somewhere in the range of \$500,000, there was also some talk of \$750,000.

Mr. Byrom mentioned that the people from APCOA would be in to

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discuss terminal parking on the 8th of April.

Herb Wright mentioned that we need to arrive at a projected income to feel reasonably safe in establishing prices, once the prices are established we should call in the airlines.

Mr. Anderson of Air Photo Survey and Global Engineering prepared a proposal of mapping and drainage area study as follows:

Plan A \$7,700.00, for two foot contours, drainage, their estimates of fill quantities

Plan B \$9,200.00, it included all of Plan A plus the Master Plan updated.
