SUBJECT: AIRPORT BOARD MEETING FRIDAY, MAY 31, 10:00 A.M.

- (1) The dyna-flect testing of all airport paved surfaces was accomplished Monday and Tuesday, May 13 and 14.

Subsequently, an engineer of Lane Wells (dyna-flect) visited with Greg Isbill to assist him in the interpretation of field data. Also, a soils engineer (Mr. Lawrence Brewer from Farmington) assisted both in the testing and analysis of data relative to the sub-grade structure and moisture content.

We are prepared to define that portion of the center section of the runway needing re-construction.

The F.A.A. District Engineer has been apprised of our intentions and has indicated approval of a program change.

We have been allocated a Federal Grant of \$94,487.00 which was to be the F.A.A. share of the Taxiway Extension Project. Mr. Kimbell agrees that the re-construction of the center section of our primary runway is our higher priority project.

Mr. Isbill will be here Friday, May 31, at 10:00 A.M. to present his findings and recommendations to the Airport Board.

It will be my recommendation that we authorize Isbill Associates to proceed with engineering design and project application without further delay.

- (2) On Wednesday, May 22, I received the proposed Terminal Modification from Frontier Airlines.* Dale Luke is studying the changes and will have an estimate later this week. There is considerable telephone and electrical circuitry to be relocated also. Mountain States will have an estimate by Friday, and our Fred Snyder will report to me regarding the electrical work. We should have a complete cost estimate for our Friday meeting.
