# Walker Field Airport Authority Special Board Meeting April 30, 1987

## Meeting Called to Order

# <u>Authorizing Resolution - Execution of a Short-Term General FBO</u> <u>Agreement</u>

Manager Miller stated that the purpose of the meeting was for the Board to consider Resolution No. 1987-009. This resolution would authorize the Airport Manager to establish a month-to-month lease agreement with the successful bidder of the Monarch Aviation, Inc. assets at the Sheriff's sale scheduled for May 1, 1987 until a new lease agreement could be negotiated and agreed upon by the Airport Authority and the successful bidder. A copy of the resolution is attached and included herein by reference.

Manager Miller read and recommended the adoption of the resolution with the following change: The second paragraph on page 2 would specify a fifteen day written notice of termination of the lease agreement instead of a thirty day written notice.

Discussion followed regarding the proposed change from thirty days written notice of termination to 15 days and a clarification of the third paragraph on page 2.

Director Love made a motion to adopt the resolution; seconded by Director Faussone.

Bernard Buescher discussed the current status of Buescher-Sparkman Investments as it pertains to the acquisition of the assets of Monarch Aviation, Inc. Minutes April 30, 1987

Director Love amended his motion to adopt the resolution as read; seconded by Director Faussone. A roll call vote carried the motion unanimously. Absent were Directors Albers and Theobold.
