## JANUARY 10, 2007 MEETING

Richard called the meeting to order at 10:10 AM.

Doug Briggs presented the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Grand Junction and the Horizon Drive Business Improvement District concerning payment of the I-70 improvements. There is specific wording that protects the District from future liability concerning the construction. The date will be change to February 1, 2007 for the first payment from HDBID to the City. A motion was made by Dan to accept the memorandum of Agreement with the City of Grand Junction with the first payment due on February 1, 2007, second by Dale. Unanimous Richard reported that he asked Doug to review the Agreement with Carter Burgess for the long-range plan. Once Richard and Doug are satisfied with the wording, and the Agreement is signed, Richard will contact Teri to set up a press release for the signing.
