Barbara Creasman explained to the board her discussion with Sam Mamet concerning a TIF extension. Sam indicated that extending the sunset of the TIF is "doable" but it may not be easy. Sam indicated that Barbara needs to touch base with Ron Teck and then he would like to talk to Ron Teck about the process for TIF extension and get an amendment to state legislature by 2002.

Sam also asked Barbara to contact all the other DDA's and see where they are on this issue. His initial feelings is that URA's do not need to be included at this time. Barbara will contact other DDA's in Colorado to see where they are on this issue.

P.J. McGovern passed out a list of potential ideas for marketing the increases in the parking rates along with a color photo of a parking structure in Boulder, CO. The Board agreed that the 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> proposals were the best to bring forward to the City Council members.
