Bill had mentioned drainage out on E ½ Road and looking for ideas. Mesa County waiting to hear on Long Park grant application. Audubon waiting to hear on NCRS grant. Will be included in part of Corn Lake. 16-acre lake but only 5 to 8 feet deep. Interruptive kiosks at Jarvis are installed.
