Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate speed limit for the segment of Manor Avenue from N 20th Street to N 22nd Street was conducted on May 8, 2015. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 6 section 615 Part 2 and Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 2003 Model Traffic Code, section 7B.15 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2009 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in his opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Manor Ave. is a local residential street in an older neighborhood. Curb, gutter & sidewalk on one side only. Average street width of 24ft. and approx. 1156ft in length. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).



Speed Regulation:

A posted speed limit of 20 MPH on Manor Ave. from N 20th St. to N 22nd St. has been established.
