The meeting was called to order at 2:03 p.m. Those present were Alternate Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver, and Deputy City Clerk Juanita Peterson.

 Colorado Mesa University Foundation, 1100 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – "Ride the Rockies Beer Garden – 2015" on June 13, 2015 from 12:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m., on the lawn area west of the Plaza, between Escalante Hall and Dominquez Hall on CMU campus, Grand Junction, CO, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous Pres./Sec'y. of Org.: Peggy Lamm, 507 Dove Ct., Grand Junction, CO 81507 Events Manager: Jennifer Stoll, 2508 Van Buren Ave., Grand Junction, CO 81505

Ms. Gail Howe, Program Coordinator, and Ms. Jennifer Stoll, Events Manager were present.

Ms. Peterson reported that all the paperwork is in order and reports are in compliance.

City Attorney Shaver handed Ms. Howe three pages. The first two pages were marked with an "A" in the upper right hand corner and the next document with a "B" (see attached). City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Howe if she is familiar with these documents. She answered yes, that she completed these documents. City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Howe whose signature that was on the second page of Exhibit A. She said it was hers. City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Howe to describe the event. Ms. Howe said this will be a beer garden on the campus for the headquarters of Ride the Rockies event beginning point. Ms. Howe said they will have Citadel Security in uniforms and CMU volunteers in bright green vests for the entire event. Only 21 and over will be admitted through the gates after ID's are checked and given a wristband. The beer garden will be fenced in around the perimeter by fencing provided by Your Way Safety and Design. Vendors with food will be located in the plaza. They will have entertainment which will conclude at 9:00 p.m. There will only be one entrance and exit into the beer garden.

Alternate Hearing Officer Starritt asked if there was anyone present who would like to speak on this matter.

Mr. Clark Carroll, a resident in the area who is surround on three sides by CMU campus, he said he has no issue with this event, but wondered when there is an alcohol event at the campus who's jurisdiction is it, the University or Grand Junction Police?

City Attorney Shaver explained that the City of Grand Junction Police Department has a satellite station on the campus but they are City of Grand Junction Police Officers. City Attorney Shaver said if Mr. Carroll is having issues to call 911 or the non-emergency number of 242-6707.

Alternate Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there were no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, and its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that the application for a special event permit submitted by Colorado Mesa University Foundation was in order and approved it.

Ms. Peterson reported that all the paperwork is in order and reports are in compliance.

City Attorney Shaver handed Mr. Fuoco three pages. The first two pages were marked with an "A" in the upper right hand corner and the next document with a "B" (see attached). City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Fuoco if he is familiar with these documents. He answered yes, that he completed these documents. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Fuoco whose signature that was on the second page of Exhibit A. He said it was his. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Fuoco to describe the event. Mr. Fuoco said this will be a wedding reception held in the Lodge. They have hosted these in the past but this is the first one this year and they will only be in the main hall. Citadel Security and Lodge officers will perform the security for this event. They will have a catered banquet. Only 21 and over will be given a wristband after ID's are checked.

Alternate Hearing Officer asked about the time of the event, why end at 11:50 p.m.? Mr. Fuoco said that is last call at the lodge with their bartenders.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Fuoco if there have been any issues in the past. Mr. Fuoco said yes at a Quinceanera over a year ago, in the parking lot.

Alternate Hearing Officer Starritt asked if there was anyone present who would like to speak on this matter. There was no one.

Alternate Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there were no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, and its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that the application for a special event permit submitted by Grand Junction Lodge No. 270, Loyal Order of Moose was in order and approved it.

Ms. Beckner said her only concern is this has been over the winter months and she isn't sure how many events even happened.

After a general discussion, it was agreed by Ms. Beckner, Ms. Collar, City Attorney Shaver, and Alternate Hearing Officer Starritt to give it another 90 days and then another review will take place. Ms. Peterson will let the manager of the Ale House know this. If there are still not issues it will just be an update for the Authority.


