**Urban Trails Committee
Minutes
October 8, 2002**

Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 7:15pm by co-chair, Jamie Lummis. Those present from the Committee were:

Approval of Minutes

Ken/Janet motioned to approve minutes from August and September.

Announcements

Ken to attend the RFC meeting. Meeting will be in Fruita and 325 E. Aspen and start at 5:30pm.

Jamie introduced David Lane to the group. David is interested in being a member of UTC.

There were no further announcements.

Old Business

Ken explained needed changes to UTC Master Plan map. Keith showed Ken Simms' questions and changes on the draft UTC Master Plan map. Group discussed questions and concerns. Keith explained that the City and County have a joint agreement. He talked about UTC removing trails from areas outside jointly agreed upon by the two entities. He also talked about the County's issues with the canal trails shown on the map in outlying areas. The group then went through each question Keith and Ken Simms had on the revised map.

Talked about paved improved and unimproved in outlying areas. Talked about routes being out in rural areas but lanes should be within urbanizing area. Will sign as routes for now but will change to lanes in the future. Long discussion on Redlands area and need for attachment and box stating so on the map or statement referring them to Community Development file.

Jody asked Keith what he wants next. Keith said he and Ken Simms would take care of changes. Clark and other UTC members will go and look at questionable areas and then contact Keith or Ken Simms directly with comments.

Ken Scissors asked where does the group politically go next. Ken Simms wants to have meeting with his staff. Everyone agreed new map would need to go back to every group for their approval.

Jamie discussed County's issue with canal banks on map. Talked about problems with going back to County. Jamie is reluctant to go back through that process again. Keith suggested doing a joint workshop. Jamie feels City will give approval but County won't. Keith said both have to agree. Ken Scissors feels the only way County will agree is if there are two maps (one with canal banks and one without). Jamie doesn't agree and doesn't think canal banks should be taken off the map. Jamie suggested getting map done with changes and then can see what everyone has a problem with. Keith explained that last time, they didn't have problem with revisions, it was with the canal banks and that would have to be a separate issue. Janet asked what happens if the canal company's attorney shows up again. Keith highly recommends having a joint meeting.

Group thanked Keith for coming.

Jamie has meeting with Greg Strong to show him canal bank agreement. Thursday, Jamie/Robert/Dan Wilson will be looking at aerials for the north side. Jamie asked Clark if he could attend meeting at 1:30pm. Clark said yes.

Preliminary Route – Jody said tabled until area developed.

Property Trade – Tim was unable to attend.

Outreach/Public Awareness – Nothing to report. Will get together and work on an agenda. Jamie gave them a copy of this State Trails Newsletter regarding grant applications for 2003 with deadline being in November.

There was no further old business.
