

## CITY COUNCIL.

At the meeting of the City Fathers on the evening of Nov. 1st, there were present W. H. Talbott, mayor, W. E. Shaffer, clerk, W. T. Carpenter, Jno. Hynes, Geo. Shackleton, Trustees. Town Treasurer, Clerk and Police Judge made reports which were accepted.

Bills were presented and allowed:

bill of Rice Bros. for \$3.65 was passed for correction.

A motion was made and seconded that the retail liquor licence be increased to \$800, per annum. An amendment fixing the licence at \$600, was offered. The ayes and nos were called as follows: W. H. Talbott, no; W. E. Shaffer, no; W. T. Carpenter, George Shackleton, Jno. Hynes, all ayes. Two-thirds of the entire board being necessary the amendment was lost. The original motion was then tabled. Ordered that salaries for November be allowed and warrants drawn.

On Wednesday evening the entire board was present. Bills were allowed: Jas. Higgins, \$3.85.

City Attorney was ordered to investigate and report on the following bill: J. A. Layton, \$110.00. The resignation of S. Van Horn as City Marshal was accepted. Jack Barrett was then elected to fill the vacancy, unanimously.

A motion was made to take up the original motion on the question of liquor licence, increasing retail licence to \$600, annum. Vote was as follows: W. H. Talbott, no; W. S. Binning, aye; W. T. Carpenter, aye; Jno. Hynes, aye; Geo. Shackleton, aye; W. E. Shaffer, no. The motion was so carried and so ordered. The revised ordinances as reported by the City Attorney were then passed.
