

# PROCEEDINGS OF TOWN COUNCIL.

May 4th, '85.—Meeting called to order at eight o'clock, Mayor O. D. Russell in the chair.

The Recorder being absent, H. C. Bucklin was on motion appointed to act as Recorder *pro tem*. All other members were present.

The reports of G. B. Frazier acting Police Magistrate and those of ex-Treasurer W. A. Marsh and J. F. McFarland for the month of April, were read and approved.

The official bonds of Marshall Barrett, Street Commissioner Waller and Treasurer McFarland were each approved.

May 5.—Meeting called to order by Mayor. All members answered to the roll call and minutes of last meeting approved.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

*Resolved:* That the purchase by the Town of Grand Junction of two hundred and twenty-seven shares of stock in the Mesa County Ditch Company be recalled and that the Recorder be instructed to tender and deliver up to said Mesa County Ditch, the stock heretofore issued by said company to the Town, and demand of said company the purchase price paid by said Town therefor.

The bid of the Pacific Slope Ditch was then accepted to furnish the town with water for the ensuing year.

The bid of Price and Kingsley for the city printing was read and a motion made to accept the same, but was lost. The clerk was then instructed to notify both papers to put in sealed bids at the next regular meeting for the city printing for the year. It was moved and carried that the ordinances already passed be published in the GRAND JUNCTION NEWS.

A number of bills were then allowed.

A committee of three were then appointed to visit Daniel Mullen's ranch and report what damages if any had been done him by waste water from the town. The Mayor appointed John Hynes and S. W. Coleman and Street Commissioner Waller.
