

NEW COUNCIL.

The illness of Mr. J. T. Sharp forced the new Council to meet with an absence on Monday night. After coming to order, Petition of Butler and Donnelly for location of saloon between Fourth and Fifth streets was laid on the table indefinitely. Petition for two plank side walk down east side of Second street to Ute avenue was granted and order recorded that property holders be notified. The following committees were then appointed:

Finance: Crandall, Hynes, Bucklin.

Streets and Alleys: Coleman, Bucklin, Sharp.

Licenses: Bucklin, Hynes, Crandall.

Water: Crandall, Sharp, Coleman.

Marshall's salary was fixed at \$75 per month and Street Commissioners at the same.

Ordinance to amend revised ordinances so that City Treasurer should draw \$10 per month salary was lost. Russell and Crandall voting no, Sharp absent.

Moved and carried that printing be let to lowest bidder.

One vote was taken on the election of a city marshal.

W. J. S. Henderson received three votes and J. F. Harrell two, no election.

Board adjourned for one week.
