#### 2007 Police Pension Rates

Human Resources Manager Claudia Hazelhurst distributed the 2007 Pension Rates to the board members and the pensioners that were present. She advised that all pensioners will be receiving 2.7% COLA (Cost of Living Allowance) increase and those qualifying for a rank increase will receive 3%. One pensioner, Willa Davis, passed away in August, 2006. City Manager Varley asked for clarification on one pensioner (Johnson) at 121%. Ms. Hazelhurst explained that the pensioner's spouse retired in a position that no longer exists so the pension is calculated based on the percentage difference the abolished position bore to the rank of police officer at the time the pensioner retired. There are other pension rates that are calculated that way.

Stephanie Tuin moved to approve the 2007 Police Pension rates for retirees. David Varley seconded. Motion carried.

# Other Business

Administrative Services Director Ron Lappi advised that the State of Colorado has so far still budgeted the funding for the liability of the Old Hire Police Pension Fund. The City too is continuing to contribute to the unfunded liability.
