MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE POLICEMEN'S  
PENSION FUND OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

Meeting was held in the office of City Manager Cheever at 2 o'clock P. M. on August 26, 1957. Mr. Cheever, Chairman; Helen Tomlinson, Board Member, and Carl Davis, recently appointed representative on the Board from the Police Department were present. Fred E. Hagie, City Treasurer was absent. Helen Tomlinson was appointed as Secretary to the Board.

The application of Henry M. Patterson, formerly a Captain in the Police Department, for retirement under the Police Pension Fund law was read. Mr. Patterson resigned from the Police Department effective August 1st, 1957, after having been employed in such department for a period of 22 years. Mr. Patterson has reached the age of 59 years. Under a new law passed by the 1957 Legislature, a member of a Police Department is eligible for retirement when he has reached the age of 55 years and has been employed for 20 years.

It was moved by Mr. Cheever and seconded by Mr. Davis that Henry M. Patterson be placed on Police Pension, effective August 1st, at a salary of \$205.20 per month, which is one-half of the average salary received by him during the past twelve months.
