MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
POLICEMEN'S PENSION FUND OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION,  
COLORADO.

A called meeting of the Trustees of the Grand Junction Policemen's Pension Fund of the City of Grand Junction was held in the office of the City Clerk at 4 o'clock P. M. on Wednesday, August 1st, 1962. Present were Chairman, Joe M. Lacy, City Manager; Carl Davis, Member of the Police Department; and Helen C. Tomlinson, City Clerk and Secretary of the Board.

Mr. John H. Dickey, A detective on the Police Department made application for retirement under the Police Pension Law. Mr. Becker has served 24 years as a member of the Department and is 56 years of age, and is eligible for retirement. He asked that his retirement be effective on August 1st, 1962. It was moved by Carl Davis and seconded by Helen Tomlinson that Mr. Dickey's request be granted and that he be placed on Police Pension Fund at the rate of \$227.00 uper month, which is one-half of the amount of money which he earned during the preceding 12 months. Motion carried.

It was reported that Mrs. Edith Harris had passed away on May19, 1962. City Manager Lacy requested that Mr. Charles Green, Finance Director make a study of the actuarily soundness of the Police Pension Plan. There being no further business to come before the meeting it was regularly moved, seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn.
