The Police Pension Board met at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 30th, 1965. Present were City Manager, Joe Lacy, Chairman; Wm. Manchester, City Treasurer; Carl Davis, representative of the Police Department; Helen Tomlinson, City Clerk and Secretary of the Board; and Gerald J. Ashby, City Attorney.

It was reported that Robert E. Johnson, Detective in the Police Department had passed away on December 22nd. He leaves a widow, Marilyn Johnson and two minor sons, David E. Johnson, born May 6, 1958 and Steven W. Johnson, born on Feb. 2, 1955.

It was moved by Carl Davis and seconded by Wm. Manchester that Marilyn Johnson be granted a pension from the Police Pension Fund of \$121.50 per month, or one-fourth of Mr. Johnson's salary, and that Marilyn Johnson, natural guardian of Steven W. Johnson, a minor be granted a pension of \$60.75 per month until Steven is 16 years of age; and that Marilyn Johnson, natural guardian of David E. Johnson be granted a pension of \$60.75 per month until David is 16 years of age. The pension is contingent upon Mrs. Johnson's remaining unmarried.
