

POLICE PENSION BOARD MINUTES

December 12, 1974

The Police Pension Board met in the City Manager's Office at City Hall at 9:15 a.m. Thursday, December 12, 1974, for the purpose of considering the request by John L. McFall for retirement effective December 31, 1974. Members present: City Manager Harvey Rose, Finance Director Victor Vance, Police Representative Captain Mike Chesnick, and City Clerk Neva Lockhart. Pat Bittle, Personnel Assistant was also present.

Finance Director Vance presented payroll records which indicated that Mr. McFall was paying into Social Security through 1965-55 after which time he joined the Police Pension Fund. Contained in Mr. McFall's Personnel file was his swearing-in statement signed by Mr. McFall and by City Manager Toyne dated 1956. Mr. Vance submitted that in view of these records, he would not be in favor of granting Police Pension Fund benefits to Mr. McFall as it appears he is short of eligibility by one year.

It was moved by Mr. Vance and seconded by Captain Chesnick to table this item for one week so the Board can seek the advice of the City Attorney. Motion carried.
