

## Indemnity Bond

Know all men by these presents, That we N. J. Kruseu of Grand Junction Mesa County Colorado as principal and W. S. Parks and Frank Parks of Barnard Pawnee County Kansas, and W. G. Reeve, of Peru Peasdale County Illinois as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the town of Grand Junction in the penal sum of Ten thousand Dollars, lawful money of the United States for the payment of which well and truly to be made we hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors administrators and assigns, jointly and severally finally by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this first day of December ad 1888

The conditions of the above obligations are such that whereas, the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction Mesa County Colorado, did on the 23rd day of November 1888 by an Ordinance duly passed, grant to N. J. Kruseu his associates successors and assigns a franchise for the erection and construction of a system of Water Works in said Town and whereas said Kruseu has filed with the Recorder of said Town his acceptance in writing of all the terms and conditions of said Ordinance, now if the said, Kruseu his associates successors and assigns shall faithfully and diligently prosecute the work of erection and construction of said Water Works and complete the same and commence the operation thereof on or before the 15th day of April ad 1889 then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.



Provided however that if the said N J Krusen his associates, successors and assigns shall well and truly enter into the construction of the said water works in good faith and shall diligently prosecute the same and shall be unable to complete the same by the time specified herein by reason of stress of weather, blockades on the Railroads strikes among their employees, or by fire flood or other acts of Providence over which they have no control the same shall work an extension of the time mentioned herein for the completion of the same, not to exceed thirty days.

Provided further that said Krusen his associates successors and assigns shall pay to the said Trustees as liquidated damages for such delay the sum of \$10<sup>00</sup> per day for the first 10 days or less, \$15<sup>00</sup> per day for the next 10 days and \$20<sup>00</sup> per day for the next 10 days
