

POLICE PENSION BOARD MEETING

May 10, 1976

The Police Pension Board met at 8:30 a.m. Monday, May 10, 1976, in the City Manager's office at City Hall. Members present were Police Representative Harvey Gorby, City Manager Harvey Rose, Finance Director Victor Vance, and City Clerk Neva Lockhart. Assistant City Manager James E. Wysocki was also present.
