THE POLICE PENSION BOARD MET AT 1:30 P.M. JANUARY 26, 1977 IN THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE AT CITY HALL. MEMBERS PRESENT WERE POLICE REPRESENTATIVE HARVEY GORBY, CITY MANAGER JIM WYSOCKI, ACTING FINANCE DIRECTOR JOHN TASKER, CITY CLERK NEVA LOCKHART. ACTING PERSONNEL DIRECTOR CLAUDIA SMITH WAS ALSO PRESENT.

THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS THE NOTICE OF DEATH OF RETIRED POLICE CAPTAIN HENRY M. PATTERSON ON JANUARY 18, 1977. IT WAS MOVED BY HARVEY GORBY AND SECONDED BY NEVA LOCKHART THAT PEARL MAE PATTERSON RECEIVE BENEFIT PAYMENT OF \$395 MONTHLY EFFECTIVE JANUARY 19, 1977, PLUS ANY ESCALATOR BENEFITS ACCRUING THEREAFTER UNTIL SUCH TIME AS SHE MAY REMARRY OR UNTIL HER DEATH. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED BY CHAIRMAN WYSOCKI.
