The Police Pension Board met on May 19, 1992, at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room A at City Hall. Those present were Sgt. Gary Richardson, Administrative Services Director Ron Lappi, Personnel Manager Claudia Hazelhurst, and Acting City Clerk Teddy Martinez.

The meeting was called to order by Ron Lappi.

Claudia Hazelhurst presented the Letter of Retirement from Lt. Harvey Gorby, effective June 1, 1992. Upon motion by Gary Richardson, seconded by Ron Lappi and carried, the Letter of Retirement from Lt. Harvey Gorby was accepted.

Claudia gave an update on the computation of limited rank escalation for those employees retiring under the 25 years of service option. This could affect 4 to 6 of the current and future Police retirees by reducing the amount of their pension subject to full rank and increasing the portion subject to limited rank. More discussion will take place with FPPA, Don Mazanec, who was the consultant on the rank escalation buy-out project. Another meeting will be called for a decision on this matter.

Upon motion by Gary Richardson, seconded by Ron Lappi and carried, the meeting was adjourned.


