- \* The City Clerk reported to the Local Licensing Authority that shortly after permission was granted to Laura Gwen Farnum to change the location of her retail liquor store license from 401 North Avenue to 201 North Avenue, all construction at 201 North Avenue ceased. Conversation with Mr. Tom Goerke, representative of Laura Franum, a month or so ago, revealed that the financing he had arranged for the construction of the building on the property fell through, and he was trying to put together another financial package. Mr. Tom Goerke was present and detailed some of his problems. He indicated that it could be next May or June before a building was ready for the move. Mr. Coebergh stated that the licensee, Laura Gwen Farnum, should be present for the meeting. Mr. Coebergh tabled consideration of the application until October 19, 1988, in order to give the licensee an opportunity to:
- 1. Provide documentation as to when the building will be ready for occupancy;
- 2. Consider filing an application to change the location back to 401 North Avenue.
