Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate speed limit for the segment of Welig Ct. from F 1/2 Rd to end of street was conducted on July 2, 2015. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 6 section 615 Part 2 and Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 2003 Model Traffic Code, section 7B.15 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2009 and the City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in his opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Welig Ct. is a local residential street in an older neighborhood. Curb & gutter with no sidewalk. Average street width of 28ft. and approx. 688 ft in length. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

A posted speed limit of 20 MPH on Welig Ct. from F 1/2 Rd. to end of street has been established.
