City Clerk Stephanie Nye stated that the Grand Junction Police Department reports that there were two incidents last fall of sales to a minor by an employee of Horizon Liquors. Mr. Mike Haldeman, owner of Horizon Liquors, stated that the employee is no longer under his employ.

Hearing Officer Phil Coebergh explained to Mr. Haldeman that the license will be approved at the local level, and forwarded to the State for approval. It is always subject to possible review if the City determines that the problems have been significant enough to conduct a separate hearing on this application. If that were the case, Mr. Haldeman would be notified of the hearing.
