- B. City Market Store No. 18, 2830 North Avenue (3.2% Beer)  
The application was in order and approved.
- C. Chupiro's Place, 122 S. 5th Street (Tavern)  
Police report that Alfredo Martinez did plead guilty to a third degree assault, domestic dispute, and received a suspended sentence. The application was in order and approved.

III. **APPLICATIONS FOR CHANGE IN CORPORATE STRUCTURE**

- A. Application by Martinez Family Corporation dba Chupiro's Place, 122 S. 5th Street, for a change in corporate structure, dropping Jose L. Martinez, Vice President, from the license. Irene Prieto has bought out the 25% of stock owned by Mr. Martinez. She is now a 50% stock-holder.

Cindy Enos Martinez representing the Martinez Family Corporation was present. She was instructed by Hearing Officer Coebergh to notify the City as soon as any changes occur. Application was approved.
