I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> - The meeting convened at 8:10 a.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Philip Coebergh, Assistant City Attorney John Shaver, and City Clerk Stephanie Nye.

II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

A. Skys Restaurant & Lounge, 2828 Walker Field Drive (Hotel-Restaurant and Extended Hours)

Hearing Officer Phil Coebergh stated that this application was filed late. There was no one present representing this application.

City Clerk Stephanie Nye noted that the application was in order. The applicant was advised by letter from the City Clerk that in the future renewal applications must be made 45 days before the expiration date of the license. This application was filed 22 days prior to that date. The reason given by the applicant Stephen Robertson for late filing was because of lack of funds.

Assistant City Attorney John Shaver said that the State Statute does allow the Local Licensing Authority to waive the 45 days filing if good cause is shown. "Good cause" is a discretionary kind of determination. There is no specific case law in this context that determines what "good cause" is. For that reason, the application was accepted.

The renewal application was approved.
