D. 1882, the Commissioners heretofore duly appointed by the county court of said county, to call and hold an election of the qualified electors residing within the limits of the proposed incorporated town of Grand Junction, in said county and state, to decide upon the proposition to incorporate the said town.
And filed in the office of the clerk of said court their report of an election for the purposes herein before stated, held at the office of the Grand Junction Town company, at and within the limits of the said town of Grand Junction, on the 23d day of June, A. D. 1882, at which election it appears from the returns thereof, duly certified, sixty-two votes were cast in favor of the incorporation of the said town, and one vote was cast against the incorporation of same, a majority of said votes cast at said election being in favor of the incorporation of said town. And it appearing that the number of inhabitants residing within the limits of said town does not exceed three hundred, notice is hereby given that when the incorporation thereof shall be completed the said town of Grand Junction will belong to that class of municipal corporations designated by and under the laws of the state of Colorado as an incorporated town.

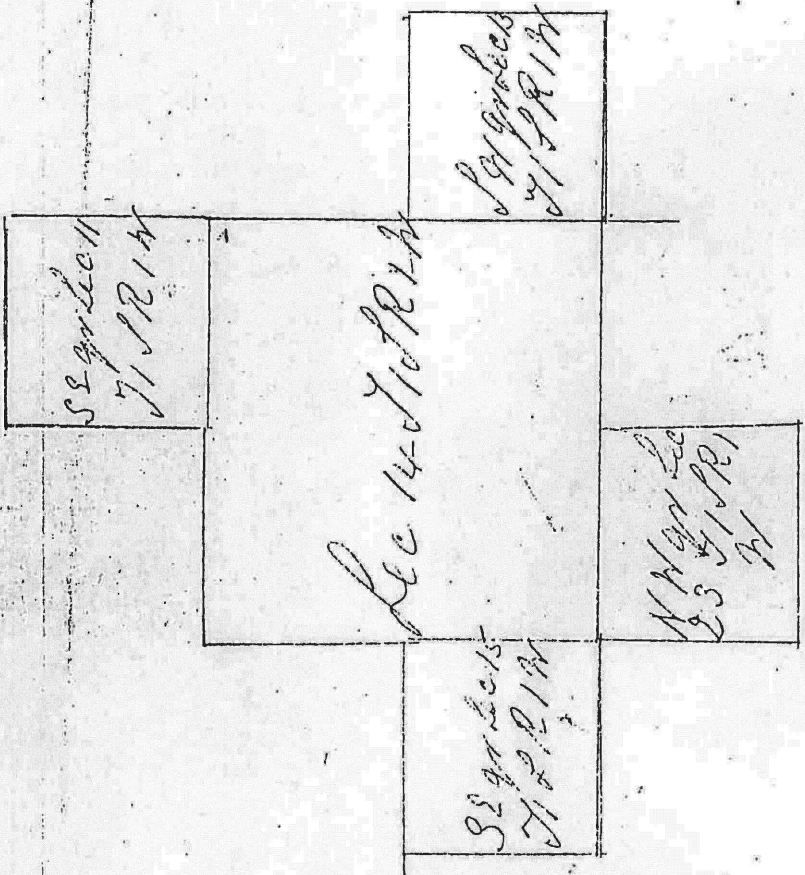
