WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 1996, 8:00 A.M.

I. CALL TO ORDER - The meeting was convened at 8:06 a.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Phil Coebergh, Assistant City Attorney John Shaver and City Clerk Stephanie Nye.

II. APPLICATION TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

1. Thomas P. Campbell and J.R. Wagler Etal dba Last Chance Liquor Store, 1203 Pitkin Avenue, Retail Liquor Store

The application was in order and approved.

2. Loda Incorporated dba Mama Longo's, 2830 North Avenue, Beer and Wine

The application was in order. The Fire Department reported two violations but does not see a reason to withhold the license. The license was approved contingent upon the correction of the two Fire Code violations.

3. Bobby D. and Amy M. Crigger dba Teller Arms Liquors, 2353 Belford Avenue, Retail Liquor Store

The application was in order and approved.

4. Crown Liquors of Western Colorado Incorporated dba Crown Liquors of Western Colorado, 285 1/2 North Avenue, Retail Liquor Store

The application was in order and approved.

5. Coronado Liquor Mart, LLC., dba Coronado Liquor Mart, 569 32 Road 3A, Retail Liquor Store - Newly Annexed

Carolyn Cady, owner, was present. City Clerk Nye was in receipt of a summons dated February 28, 1996, which had been issued to the manager, Lonnie Darnell. The offenses alleged the violation is sale of alcohol to a person under 21 years of age. Assistant City Attorney Shaver recommended the merits of the renewal application be viewed and he would evaluate the violation and file a formal complaint with the Authority to deal with it if appropriate. The application was approved subject to any complaint being filed with the

Authority.

6. Zaphod Incorporated dba River City Cafe, 748 North Avenue, Hotel-Restaurant with Extended Hours

The application was in order and approved.

7. Janice L. Baxstrom dba La Fonda Dos Rios, 209 Colorado Avenue, Hotel-Restaurant with Extended Hours

Janice Baxstrom was present but did not come forward to speak. The application was in order. A citation was issued January 14, 1995 and dismissed in June of 1995 due to lack of evidence. Assistant City Attorney Shaver stated there is a history of some problems at this location, however there are no current problems that he is aware of. He recommended approval. Hearing Officer Coebergh approved the application.
