MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 16, 2002, 9:00 A.M.

II. **APPLICATION TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES**

1. Avalon Theater Incorporated dba Avalon Theater, 645 Main Street, Arts

There is also an application for report of change in the corporate structure with Ed Lipton replacing Barbara Creasman. There was no one present representing the Avalon Theater. The applications were found to be in order and approved.

III. **APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL AND REGISTRATION OF MANAGER**

1. City of Grand Junction dba Two Rivers Convention Center, 159 Main Street, Hotel and Restaurant

Manager: Michael Eugene Brophy replaces Donna Redd

Michael Brophy was present. The applications were found to be in order. The Health Department reported 1 critical violation and a reinspection has been scheduled. A local Police report has not been received on the new manager. The applications were approved contingent upon a favorable report from the Health Department and the Police Department.

IV. **TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP- Wrigley Field**

The application for the transfer of ownership was heard at the January 2, 2002 meeting and approved. Since that time, a background check on Mr. Duke has revealed a criminal matter that was not listed on his individual history. Mr. Majors asked Mr. Shaver what his recommendation was as to pursuing this matter further. Mr. Shaver stated Mr. Majors could refer this for further investigation. Mr. Majors concurred and referred this for further investigation.
