#### MINUTES

#### WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2007 9:00 a.m.

I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> – The meeting convened at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Mike Grattan, City Attorney John Shaver, and Deputy City Clerk Juanita Peterson.

#### II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

1. P&S Inc., dba Orchard Mesa Lanes, 295 27 Road, Grand Junction, CO 81503-1905, Hotel and Restaurant

The application was found to be in order and approved.

2. Thunder Mountain Tavern, LLC dba Thunder Mountain Tavern, 2701 Hwy. 50, Grand Junction, CO 81503, Tavern

The application was found to be in order and approved.

3. Zen Garden, Inc., dba Zen Garden, 2886 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant

The application was found to be in order and approved.

4. Bold Petroleum, Inc., dba Acorn Food Store, 2222 Hwy. 6 & 50, Grand Junction, CO 81505, 3.2% Beer Retail (Off Premises)

#### III. APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

1. Myths & Legends, Inc., dba Quincy Bar and Grill, 609 Main Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Tavern

President: Adelle B. Lloyd, 574 Meadowlark Lane, Grand Junction, CO 81503 VP: William B. Lloyd, 574 Meadowlark Lane, Grand Junction, CO 81503

Both Bill and Adelle Lloyd were present. Ms. Peterson reported that all the paperwork was turned in, the premises was posted; all the reports were fine but read the police summary submitted into the record (see attached). Hearing Officer Grattan asked the relationship of Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd to Fast Eddy's. Mr. Lloyd stated he is 100% owner and that he and Adelle are 50-50 owners of

Quincy's. Hearing Officer Grattan asked if there were stock certificates issues. Mr. Lloyd answered yes.

City Attorney Shaver advised that he had visited with Mr. Lloyd in the recent past about the smoking issue on the sidewalk on the north side of the building (out front). City Attorney Shaver made reference to 5 pictures that were presented to him this morning showing the signs that are now up. Mr. Lloyd said these were temporary as they have ordered the permanent signs. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Lloyd if he took the photos. Mr. Lloyd said yes.

Adelle Lloyd gave an overview of the changes they have implemented in the last six weeks. They have not allowed backpacks into the bar, no bicycles, or dogs. They have increased the price of their liquor. They have food at happy hour. All bartenders have taken the alcohol server responsibility training. There is a person at the front door at all times, and during the busy time, there is also a person at the back door. Ms. Lloyd also explained that when someone is kicked out of the bar and asked to leave, they take a photo of them so if they return, they are trespassing and they call the police. They have used this at Fast Eddy's and find that it works. Ms. Lloyd stated you always have problems in a bar situation. They have mandatory drug testing for their employees at both establishments which they believe helps cut down on the problems.

Mr. Lloyd said there is tremendous clean up in this place. He has made the back patio area a better place for the smokers to go by putting two tables out there containers for the cigarette butts, and a spot light facing toward the building. They are in the process of doing a modification of the premise so they will be able to serve alcohol outside where the smokers are.

Hearing Officer Grattan made reference to his personal issue with his family walking down Main Street and then finally crossing to the other side due to the types of people out in front of Quincy's.

Harold Stalf, Executive Director, Downtown Development Authority was present and wanted to speak regarding issues for the downtown area. Mr. Stalf said he does not want to look at the past, only to the future with the new owners. Farmer's Market this year was affected by issues at Quincy's. Mr. Stalf has made two recent trips through the bar and the first time there were 12 people out front smoking and the second time 8. He wishes there would be a time frame for these issues to get this taken care of.

Ms. Lloyd said the "no smoking out front" sign was put up yesterday and there will be no more. They will have customers who will object and try anyway but their doorman will be watching along with the manager.

Hearing Officer Grattan encouraged the establishment to work in a timely manner to get all of the issues taken care of. That being said, he recommended approval of the transfer of ownership to Myths and Legends Inc., for the Quincy Bar and Grill. City Attorney Shaver concurred.

The following background information check was completed through local computer records information from both the Mesa County Sheriff's, Grand Junction Police departments, and based only on the information contained below as provided to include Individual History Record when provided.

I have checked the local criminal history for the last year on the person(s) and business(es) listed below. I have found nothing unusual or derogatory which would hinder the issuance of these license(s) for the persons or businesses listed below. The following summary and attached reports document police calls for service between October 01, 2006 and September 27, 2007 for the Quincy's Bar, 609 Main St, GJ.CO.

#### Summary:

A total of 227 police service calls were compiled through researching the GVCC (Grand Valley Communication Center, and GJPD records. The service calls are further broken down for each month in to number of arrests made with brief narrative summaries. Of the 227 police service calls, only 34 had actual documented involvement directly with Quincy's Bar.

The other 193 police service calls to 609 Main St had no reports to further explain the call or its relation to the call address. A majority of these calls involve the 600 Block area of where the Quincy's Bar is located and were cleared by the officer as an assist, verbal warning, or gone on arrival.

There were 15 arrests made out of the 34 calls for service and only involved patrons of the bar, none were employees.
